Call to Worship	 Choose one of the following examples of familiar scripture: "Our help is in the name of the Lord, maker of heaven and earth." (Psalm 124:8) "This is the day that the Lord has made. Let us rejoice and be glad in it!" (Psalm 118:24) "Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth. Worship the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. Know that the LORD is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture." (Psalm 100:1-3)
The Lord's Prayer	Prayer concluding with The Lord's Prayer
Affirmation of Faith	The Apostles' Creed or Psalm 23
Benediction	 Choose one of the following examples of familiar scripture: The classic Aaronic Benediction from Numbers 6:24-26: The Lord bless you and keep you, The Lord make his face to shine upon you, And be gracious to you The Lord lifts up the light of his countenance upon you And give you peace. Amen. Two from the Apostle Paul: May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen. (2 Corinthians 13:14) May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. The one who calls you is faithful, and he will do it. Amen. (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24) Based on the breastplate of St. Patrick: God go before you to guide you, God go behind you to protect you, God go beneath you to support you, God go beside you to befriend you. Be not afraid. Let the blessing of Almighty God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, descend upon you, settle in around you and make its home in you. Be not afraid. Go in peace. Amen.
